Moving Up Ceremony

For Cub Scouts, the moving up or bridging ceremony is a key milestone, one that normally takes place around the time the pack breaks for the summer. Central to that ceremony is the crossing of a bridge to mark the transition to another level of the Cub Scout world. Often packs use a replica of a bridge. But Pack 521 uses an actual bridge constructed of rope and timbers that is erected on site. When a Cub Scout reached the other end of the bridge, that would complete his advancement to the next level.

The ceremony will be held at Seneca Creek State Park, Doe Pavilion on Friday June 17, 3:00–8:00 (Come earlier if you like for fun, fishing and frisbees - we have reserved a pavilion for the full day). This is a uniform event.
